

Minimum Qualifications

- A. Education and Experience:
Must possess a high school diploma or GED. At least one (1) year of experience in wastewater systems or related environment. A comparable amount of training, education or experience may be considered by the City as a substitute for the minimum qualifications.
- B. Certifications
Valid CDL Class "B" Commercial driver's license with tank vehicle endorsement required.
- C. Knowledge, Abilities, and Skills:
Knowledge of treatment collection systems functions required. Interpersonal skills, good physical condition, and ability and willingness to perform manual tasks required. Must have skill to safely operate all standard mechanical power tools and shop equipment.


General Description

Performs maintenance, cleaning, and repairs of wastewater equipment and mains related to the lift stations and wastewater distribution systems. Installs wastewater service lines/mains, and repairs breaks. May be required to operate Utilities department vehicles.

Essential Functions

1. Installs wastewater service lines/mains, and repairs breaks.
2. Performs maintenance, cleaning, and repairs on wastewater systems and equipment.
3. Assists in electrical and mechanical maintenance on wastewater systems and equipment.
4. Removes, cleans, and replaces lift station pumps as needed. Assists in rebuilding lift stations.
5. Performs grounds maintenance functions.
6. Responsible for "on-call" duties within six months of training.
7. Attends and participates in department staff meetings.
8. Reads and interprets manuals to ensure safe and efficient operation of equipment.
9. Complies with OSHA Safety and Health rules and regulations.
10. Performs other duties as assigned.

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Essential Physical Skills

Acceptable eyesight, hearing (with/without correction), smelling, moderate lifting and carrying (up to 80 lbs.), reaching, pulling, pushing, walking, sitting, standing, kneeling, bending, balancing, stooping, climbing, crawling, driving, operating equipment. Must be able to lift and carry up to 80 pounds, and be able to climb 175 foot ladder unassisted. Employee must be able to fit, meet size/weight restrictions, and work with safety equipment in the confined spaces as small as 24" access for extended periods of time. Must be able to pass a pulmonary function test to qualify for the use of a self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) and be clean-shaven as defined by OSHA standards. Reasonable accommodations will be made for otherwise qualified individuals with a disability.

Environmental Conditions

Works inside and outside in various weather conditions in and around potentially hazardous areas with dust, dirt, noise, fumes, grease, oils, electrical energy, slippery surfaces, and vibrations. Works in or with moving objects. Work may be performed at heights up to 175 feet, and may be performed below ground level in confined spaces.
